Format is 18-Hole stroke play.

TWO (2) divisions of play are offered. A golfer can only compete in **ONE (1)** division -

- **Scratch:** The golfer's gross score is recorded as played and compared to other golfers playing in the scratch division.
- **Handicap:** The golfer's gross score is adjusted by the course handicap based upon her/his current USGA handicap index and compared to other golfers playing in the handicap division. To play in the Handicap division, the golfer **MUST** provide a current USGA GHIN (or similar) handicap index number during Registration.

USGA rules will govern play.

Range finders of any type are permitted.

Event fee includes green fee, cart rental, and range balls.

Format: 18-Hole stroke play.

Women will play from the forward, Green Tees.

Men will play from the middle, White Tees.

USGA rules will govern play. Riverwalk 'scorecard' local rules will apply.

Range finders of any type are permitted.

In the event that a rules question arises on the course and your group cannot make a decision as to proper procedure, play two (2) balls from that point and allow a member of the Committee to make the decision at the conclusion of the round (Rule 20.1c). Both balls need to be scored.

Please play ready golf.

Ensure that your scorecard is correct, including two (2) correct signatures.

Following your round, turn your scorecard in at the scoring table.

Contest Holes:

Women's Long Drive: #9.

Women's Closest to the Pin: #5.

Men's Long Drive: #15.

Men's Closest to the Pin: #17.
