As we pass our 30 year mark, we are focusing this year as the beginning of the next 30 years. Our goal is to lay the foundation for a new home, new sports complex, and to continue to provide a place for all 50+ men and women. Our History

The concept of offering sports competition for 50+ men and women began in the late 1960's in California and across the United States. The first *National Senior Games Championship* was held in St. Louis, Missouri in 1987. They've been held every two years since in different cities coast to coast.

Sam Cohen, the Physical Education Director of the East County Jewish Community Center, organized the first *San Diego Senior Olympics* in 1988. That year, there were 143 athletes entered in nine different sports.

Today, thanks to the collective efforts of our amazing sponsors, partners, supporters, and volunteers, the *San Diego Senior Games* has grown to over 2,500 athletes competing in over 33 different Olympic-style events.

Our Mission

The mission of the San Diego Senior Games Association (SDSGA) is to encourage adults, age 50 and over to carry on vigorous lives by developing and maintaining adequate personal physical fitness through regular participation in recreational activities, sports, physical fitness activities, and educational programs.


